## Main aim

To form abilities and skills appropriate to individual needs and to develop communicative skills of French Language.

### Summary

After completing the French Language and Culture module, students will gain knowledge of language and culture. Learning begins with the alphabet, polite phrases in language situations, then students will learn to write and tell about himself/herself and represent his/her place of work, leisure. Students will develop their spoken language and perform in pairs situations in their work and daily activities, watch, listen and analyze video and audio material. In practical sessions and individual studies students will use effective teaching / learning tools: multimedia, virtual learning environment, smart programs. Level A1/1 of General French is being achieved by the end of the module.
