In the text [12 pt, Justified, Spacing before 6 pt] of the summary it is necessary to:

- justify the relevance and novelty of the topic;
- indicate the extent of the research on the subject;
- define research and the objectives related to it;
- indicate the research aim and the methods used;
- briefly present the main findings of the research. It is also possible to formulate recommendations, provide insights.
