


Figure 1. Title [11 pt, Bold for 'Figure 1', Centred, Line spacing: Single, Spacing before and after 6 pt]

Body of references [Size 11 pt, Justify, First line 0,5 cm, Spacing before 6 pt, No numbering].

An alphabetical list of sources (scientific literature and other resources) used in the paper shall be provided in accordance with the APA system of referencing. The list of sources must be prepared in accordance with the provisions set forth in <u>Methodological Guidelines for Compiling of Citations</u> and <u>References in the Paper</u>.
